



## E-calculator Release Note

### Summary

- The e-calculator replaces the Excel-Tool used until February 2025 to compute Common Good Points.
- Calculating the Common Good points results in an overview of an organization's contribution to the Common Good in each of the 20 themes a Common Good Report covers.
- A Common Good Report is based on the Matrix 5.1 Workbook Full and Compact Balance Sheet available under [econgood.org](http://econgood.org)
- Only audited e-calc results Common Good Points have external assurance. Under [audit.econgood.org](http://audit.econgood.org) you can apply for external assurance (audit). The e-calc is accessible to everyone.

### Release Notes

- The e-calc 5.10 calculates results for Common Good reports based on Matrix 5.1. For Matrix 5.0 reports, the e-calc version 5.08 must be used.
- Due to changes in Matrix 5.1 small deviations in the results are possible. In particular for themes and aspects that were changed. To see an overview of changes consult section 1.7 of the Workbook Full and Compact Balance sheet 5.1
- The e-calc applies a different rounding function than the excel tool what can lead to minor differences. Results are displayed as % of total possible points in 1%-steps (excel tool applied 10%-steps).
- The e-calc applies the same underlying evaluation of company facts as the excel tool.
